Extra Curricula Activities.

This term students are being given the opportunity to participate in specialist programs to support their learning and development of skills.

On Tuesday's students are extending their music skills as they participate in an African drumming program. All students are provided with a drum and are developing their understanding of rhythm, tempo and other musical concepts.

On Friday's students are participating in the GOT games program. During this time students participate in 1 hour of physical activity further developing their fundamental movement skills and team work.

These programs are of no cost to families and are funded by the school.
